Why would a 4-H club be interested in participating in Exhibit Week?

There are several good reasons. Preparing and displaying an exhibit teaches youth teamwork, organization, how to manage their design resources, how to network with a community business, and how to put their creative ideas into action. This is a group activity in which all 4-H members can share and contribute. Best of all, participating 4-H clubs will be rewarded with a prize.



Let's see how creative your club can be in educating the public about 4-H and about your 4-H clubs. The Plymouth County Extension Office has tri-fold poster boards in black or white available for \$5 each. ***The top three exhibits will be awarded \$100, \$50 and \$30 to your 4-H Club to put towards anything for your club.***

Rules for 4-H Exhibit Week

1. Clubs must submit a completed entry form to the Plymouth County Extension Office no later than September 22. Entries received after this date will not be judged. (If you have to cancel your exhibit, please notify the office immediately.)
2. Exhibits must be on display in a public building during the week of October 1-7, 2017. 4-H Clubs should obtain permission for use of space before planning their exhibit.
3. Plymouth County 4-H brochures must be displayed with your exhibit. These may be picked up at the Plymouth County Extension Office in Hanson.
