



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Begin at A. Walk 5 steps toward B, then jog to B.
- 2. A B, stop. Back around B.
- 3. Lope on left lead to C and in a small circle around C and then on to D.
- 4. At D, stop. Execute a 180° turn on the haunches to the right.
- 5. Lope on right lead until even with A. Stop.
- 6. Exit arena at an extended jog.
